Executive Financial Details

The Riyadh Al-Ghussein Education Fund continued in the past two years to support Palestinian students to continue their higher education in Palestine and abroad.

The total number of students the Fund supported in those two years is 41, of whom 10 graduated or are about to graduate this year, and 10 new students have been added to the list for support. Of the total number 20 students are male and 21 females. 22 students have studied or are studying abroad at various universities in Europe Canada, UK, Jordan, and Turkey. Their fields of study range from business administration to the health sciences, including medicine. The majority of students who study at home are at AL-Quds university but some study at Bethlehem university, some at AL-Najah university and 3 are studying at Israeli institutions. All students are Jerusalemites. 90% of the students received partial support from the Fund while some received full support. The decision to give full or partial support depended on various factors including the cost of tuition, the place they are studying and their financial situation. The total running cost of the operation in Jerusalem has been under 5% of the donation for each year.

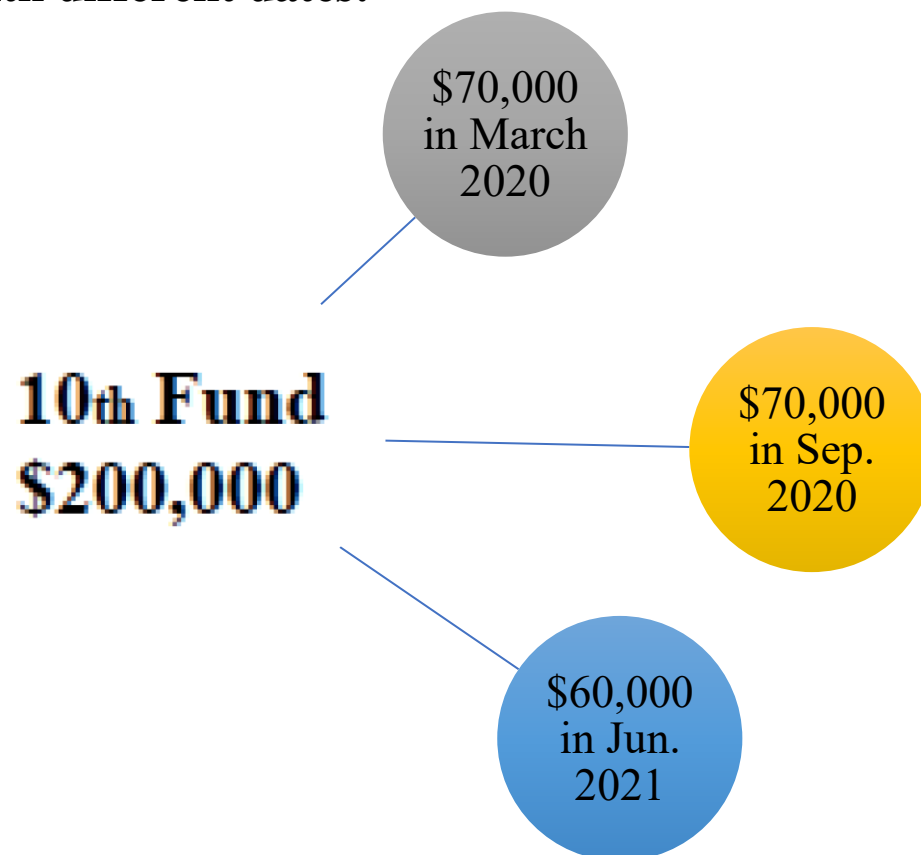
